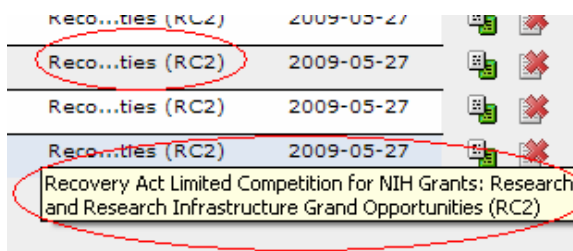

Important Note: Due to the time constraints that NIH is faced with in developing and launching this funding opportunity, all of the new validations in this FOA are in the form of WARNINGS rather than ERRORS. Therefore, it is extremely important that preparers, reviewers, and submitters read and understand the guidelines for this RFA and pay very close attention to warnings generated by the S2S Grants system. Warnings will not cause an application to be rejected by Grants.gov or the NIH Commons, but the Center for Scientific Review (CSR) may reject applications found to be non-compliant with the guidelines.
